For two weeks this summer, Special Olympics Alaska will host its third annual Camp Shriver. Thirty athletes will pair up with peer partners to discover the opportunities and experiences of participating in a sports camp program.

Camp Shriver provides participating campers an opportunity to realize their potential, develop physical fitness and experience the joys and friendships that are an integral part of camp.



There is no fee to participate in Special Olympics or in Camp Shriver.

## When is camp?

July 27 - August 7, 2009  
Sessions are Monday through Friday from 9:30 am to 3:00 pm.

## Where is camp?

Camp Shriver is based at Wendler Middle School in Anchorage, Alaska. Transportation to other locations during the day is provided by Special Olympics Alaska.

## Who goes to camp?

### Campers

Participation is open to Middle School and High School age athletes and partners. **Athletes** are individuals with intellectual disabilities. **Partners** are individuals without intellectual disabilities.

### Volunteers

These trained volunteers supervise activities and help run the day to day operations of the camp.

## What happens at camp?

Campers participate in a wide variety of sports and social activities. Camp begins with an opening ceremony and ends with an awards and closing ceremony. There is also a family day and leadership workshop.
